

Curled octopus (Eledone cirrhosa)

- The curled octopus injects toxins into its prey to help immobilise it.
- If threatened, the curled octopus can squirt a jet of ink to distract a predator.
- The curled octopus can squeeze through tiny gaps as narrow as its beak.
- The curled octopus can rapidly change colour to camouflage itself against its background.
